Venue

The symposium will be held at the Institute for Agro Technology and Rural Sciences (IARS), University of Colombo in Hambantota. The IARS was established, attached to University of Colombo in 2008 as a knowledge hub to disseminate the modern farming technologies to farmer community in southern Sri Lanka.

How to Reach IARS

From Bandaranayake International Air Port to Colombo, it takes 1hr by public transport. From Colombo to Matara it takes about 1.5hrs. via Southern Expressway.
